## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, and when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. The Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from riding on the Show Grounds. SEE USEF RULEBOOK It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee, and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance. SEE USEF RULE BOOK.

 Appropriate dress is required for all classes. Solid color polo's are permitted in hunter and jumper classes.
This is a single point show, approved by NFHJA and governed by their current rules and those of the USEF; where those rules do not apply, decision of the show management is final

4. Pre-entries close: FRIDAY, May 20th, 2011. A \$12.00 schooling fee will be charged per entry. Stalls are available for \$30. Bedding/shavings are available for \$6.50 per bag. A \$5.00 EMT fee will be charged per entry. A \$5.00 Security/Nightwatch fee will be charged per entry.

5. All championships, unless otherwise noted, are awarded to the top two of the four ponies/horses that acquire the most points performing over regulation courses with obstacles at the full height. In case of a tie, champion is awarded to the pony/horse that accumulated the most points over fences. If the ponies/ horses have an equal number of points over fences and no points under saddle, the tied horses must be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring to break the tie.

6. Year-End points will be accrued by current members only. Points will not be retroactive. The competition year runs from December 1st of the previous year through November 30 of the current year.

7. Show management reserves the right to combine or cancel any classes. The committee reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally and/or cancel awards or prizes without claim for damages and to change the order of classes or cancel or combine classes at its discretion if entries are not sufficient. If there are not sufficient entries for a division to fill, participants in that division will be awarded full year end points for the classes placed in, but no champion or reserve champion points will be awarded.

8. All schooling will be confined to schooling areas.9. In all hunter classes, ponies and horses will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners.

- 10. Order of go will be determined by the paddock master. Please notify the paddock master of all conflicts. 11. A coggins dated within one year for all horses on show grounds is required. Please send a copy with legible Accession Number with your entry.
- 12. Stalls will be available noon on Friday prior to the show.

Entry numbers <u>WILL NOT</u> be issued without an open check or credit card information left in the secretary's office.
After entries close, <u>ADD SLIPS</u> must be presented at the ring for admission into a class.
Flat classes <u>WILL NOT BE HELD</u> due to trainer conflicts.

All competition disputes will be resolved by The Show Committee & Management, which will serve as stewards. Decisions by stewards shall be final. Any protest must be made in writing at show office and must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$50.00 fee.
All horses on the grounds must be entered and checked in at the office and assigned a back number.
All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly. (This includes screw eyes or nails in stalls.)
Food service will be available on the grounds beginning the day prior to the start of each show and ending at the culmination of each show.
Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 20% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashier's check or money order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification to the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action. order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification to the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.

24. Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles; ATV'S, motorcycles, golf carts, etc., on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the violator to expulsion from the show grounds. SEE USEF RULE BOOK.

25. Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and campers, from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or unload. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE. 26. Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry

will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent, legal guardian, trainer or agent.

27. Adults showing in Adult Amateur and or Amateur Owner classes must present their amateur certification to the Show Secretary before numbers will be issued. 28. All dogs MUST BE RESTRAINED AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. Unrestrained dogs create a serious safety hazard for exhibitors

and their horses. Loose dogs will not be tolerated on the show grounds. They will be impounded and the owner will be charged a \$100 fee. 29. The owner of any horse/pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded **MUST** provide a social security number or the prize money check will not be issued.

30. Prize money will be mailed to the OWNER'S address on file. Please make sure all information is correct in the office as checks will not be reissued. All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight 31. (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable liquids such as gasoline, are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the Horse Show without recourse

32. A judge &/or management has the right to order from the ring, schooling area or show grounds any unruly horse or one whose actions threaten to endanger the rider, handler or other exhibitors. A judge &/or management has the right to order from the ring, schooling area or show grounds any rider, handler, trainer or exhibitor who exhibits inappropriate or dangerous behavior or whose actions would in any way threaten the safety of any exhibitor, their entries or the safety of class officials. SEE USEF RULE BOOK.

33. Horses & Ponies maintain NFHJA Green Status for as long as they are USEF eligible Green. There is no time limitation on NFHJA Green status and it can be reinstated if a horse or pony does not compete in more than 5 USEF rated shows.

## **RED/BLUE RIBBON WARM-UP CLASSES**

To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners and suitability as a child's mount.
