RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, and when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. The Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from riding on the Show Grounds. SEE USEF GR 801.2 It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee, and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance. SEE USEF GR318. 2. Appropriate dress is required for all classes. Solid color polo's are permitted in hunter and jumper classes. 3. This is a single point show, approved by NFHJA and governed by their current rules and those of the USEF; where those rules do not apply, decision of the show management is final.

4. Post entries will be charged a late fee of \$10.00 per entry. Entries close: FRIDAY, MAY 21, 2010. A \$12.00 schooling fee will be charged per entry. There is no schooling fee for Walk, Walk/Trot or Lead Line. Stalls are available for \$30 & MUST BE PREPAID. STALLS RESERVED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES WILL BE \$40 IF AVAILABLE. Bedding/shavings are available for \$6.50 per bag. A \$5.00 EMT fee will be charged per entry.

5. All hunter championships, unless otherwise noted, are awarded to the top two of the four ponies/horses that acquire the most points performing over regulation courses with obstacles at the full height. In case of a tie, champion is awarded to the ponyhors that accumulated the most points over fences. If the ponies/horses have an equal number of points over fences and no points under saddle, the tied horses must be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the

6. Year-End points will be accrued by current members only. Points will not be retroactive. The competition year runs from December 1st of the previous year through November 30 of the current year. Divisions may be combined or cancelled at the discretion of the Board due to insufficient entries. If there are not sufficient entries for a division to fill, participants in that division will be awarded full year end points for the classes placed in, but no champion or reserve champion points will be awarded.

7. Show management reserves the right to combine or cancel any classes. The committee reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally and/or cancel awards or prizes without claim for damages and to change the order of classes or cancel or combine classes at its discretion if entries are not sufficient.
8. All schooling will be confined to schooling areas.
9. In all hunter classes, ponies and horses will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners.
10. Order of go will be determined by the paddock master. Please notify the paddock master of all conflicts.
11. A coggins dated within one year for all horses on show grounds is required. Please send a copy with legible Accession Number with your entry.
12. Stalls will be noon on Eriday prior to the show.

 All competition disputes will be resolved by The Show Committee & Management, which will serve as stewards. Decisions by stewards shall be final. Any protest must be made in writing at show office and must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$50.00 fee.
 All borses on the grounde must be entered and checked in at the office and assigned a back number.

21. All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly. (This includes screw eyes or nails in stalls.)
23. Food service will be available on the grounds beginning the day prior to the start of each show and ending at the culmination of each show.
24. Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 20% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashier's check or money order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification to the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.
25. Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles; ATV'S, motorcycles, golf carts, etc., on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and campers, from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or unload. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.
27. Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted.
28. Adults showing in Adult Amateur and or Amateur Owner classes must present their amateur certification to the Show Secretary before numbers will be issued.
29. All dogs MUST BE RESTRAINED AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. Unrestrained dogs create a serious safety hazard for exhibitors and their horses. Loose dogs will not be tolerated on the show grounds. They will be impounded and

Prize money will be mailed to the OWNER'S address on file. Please make sure all information is correct in the office as checks will not be reissued 32. All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable liquids such as gasoline, are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the Horse Show without recourse

33. A judge &/or management has the right to order from the ring, schooling area & horse show any unruly horse or one whose actions threaten to endanger the rider, handler or other exhibitors. A judge &/or management has the right to order from the ring, schooling area & horse show any rider, handler, trainer or exhibitor who exhibits inappropriate or dangerous behavior or whose actions would in any way threaten the safety of any exhibitor, their entries or the safety of class officials. RED/BLUE RIBBON WARM-UP CLASSES

All warm-up classes will be run as a blue ribbon/red ribbon class and will be open throughout the day in the applicable ring. One Red/Blue Ribbon round per fence height, per horse/rider combination, as time permits. A score of 77-100 will earn a Blue Ribbon and a score of 70-76 will earn a Red Ribbon. May be cancelled at Management's discretion. \$10.00 class

No in-and-out. May trot or canter courses. To be judged on manners and consistency. Under Saddle class to be judged at the walk & trot only. \$10.00 class

Rider not eligible to compete in any other over fences class at the same show, with the exception of crossbars but may compete in any other flat or under saddle class which he/she is eligible for. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners and suitability as a child's mount. Extreme speed will be penalized. \$10.00 class
